

MARINE ATLANTIC TYPES OF COMMERCIAL RESERVATIONS



REGULAR

Any commercial trade vehicle in excess of 5,400kg.



LAST-MINUTE

On every crossing, two spaces are reserved for urgent, last-minute vehicles that must be transported. These spaces are first-come, first-served and are available 12 hours prior to each scheduled sailing. They will remain available up until 2 hours before the scheduled sailing time. Cost is double the regular posted tariff fee and is non-refundable.



OVERSIZED

- Overwide: greater than 9 feet 6 inches in width
 - Overlong: greater than 90 feet in length

LIVESTOCK

Any vehicle carrying animals such as cattle, horses, sheep, swine, goats, mules, poultry, game animals, llamas and alpacas.

Availability:

Designated commercial and passenger ferries will transport livestock.

Requirements:

It is the responsibility of the shipper to meet the requirements for livestock outlined in Marine Atlantic's Passenger and General Tariff Guidelines, available at www.marine-atlantic.ca, and as prescribed by law.



DANGEROUS GOODS

Any good identified within the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act*. View the Act and other important information at: www.tc.gc.ca/eng/tdg/act-menu-130.htm

Availability:

Dangerous Goods are transported primarily on the Port aux Basques-North Sydney ferry route via a designated commercial ferry. During periods when a designated commercial vessel is not available, passenger ferries will transport the material on designated crossings. Contact **1-800-341-7981** for sailing information.

Requirements:

Transportation of dangerous goods documentation must be provided when booking a reservation.
